- Display signage at the event (LOGOS, and websites to be sent to Spectrum Tech 2 weeks before the event)
- Display signage on the online global platform.
- Display links to their business/website in-person and on the online global platform.
- 2 tickets to the event if they choose to attend, for them and a support person.
- Attendance is not mandatory.
