Please accept this letter as an introduction to Spectrum Tech Trade School, Village, and Training Center. Our Mission is to create a cross-sector collaborative network that provides job training, employment opportunities, and housing for autistic individuals through our vocational schools, agricultural innovation centers, neurodivergent affirming villages, and global online platform. Our goal is to address the dire statistics that 90 % of autistic adults are unemployed or underemployed, and 50% of 25-year-olds have never held a paying job. In addition, the statistics show two-thirds are victims of bullying, autistics have three-times the suicide rate, 60% have reported PTSD-like symptoms, and 9 out of 10 autistic women are victims of sexual assault. These statistics show a failure of the current autism services system to provide adequate education, job training, and support networks to allow autistics to live safe and productive lives.

On October 15th we are planning to host our First Annual Wine Tasting and Global Autistic Art Festival at Hopewell Valley Vineyards to amplify autistic talent. At this event, we would be raising money for an in-person weekly weekend program that would provide a proof of concept for our Monday through Friday school utilizing our proprietary intensive, therapeutic, strength-based, experiential learning model, and allow us to expand our reach beyond our four walls by creating a global online learning platform.

To show our support for autistics locally and globally, and to amplify autistic talent, we will also be offering an online virtual event portion to be broadcast during the in-person event. During this event autistic influencers, artists, and entrepreneurs, will be speaking and posting a toast. This aligns with our vision of a world where not only do we educate and support autistics, but we learn from and are inspired by them. Autistic speakers and artists will be able to promote their art, businesses, and websites on our platform with 100% of the sales going directly to them.

We think our efforts would go even further with you as a sponsor.
